



Guidelines for visits to Sri Guru Singh Sabha Gurdwara Reading

The Gurdwara welcomes all visitors as our guests and would like you in return to observe the following:

1. All heads must be covered when entering the Gurdwara, we recommend you bring your own scarves or similar with you, HATS are not recommended (*Head covering can be provided on request on the day too*)
2. Footwear must be removed before entering the religious hall.
3. *As a mark of respect, if you wish, you can fully bow your head to our holy scriptures (optional).*
4. Alcohol, tobacco, drugs and meat products (including eggs and fish) are not allowed onto the Gurdwara premises (including meat filled sandwiches).
5. Gurdwara helpers/volunteers will be present to guide you on the day of the visit.
6. At the end of the visit we would like to invite you for a communal meal in the langar hall, This is vegetarian meal and is nut free (*If you have any dietary requirements please contact before visit and we will do our best to support*)
